THE POSITION

The Upper School Latin teacher will be expected to help with organizing student participation in periodic Latin festivals and conferences. The position would also require holding regular Latin study labs for students who need extra language practice.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate for the Upper School Latin Teacher position will have 3-5 years of teaching experience at a classical Christian school and:
